**The City plans to install 900 light poles around the lake**

- More light poles along the West Lawther shoreline
- More light poles in lakeshore parking lots
- 600 light poles on the nature trail

**These lights would ruin the night ambience of the park  
They would ruin the natural areas**

- Tell the City to remove the West Lawther light poles
- Tell them to plan no more light poles on West Lawther
- Plan no more lights on the shoreline or nature trail
- No Parking After Dark in the park  
Unless the lot serves a specific night use:  
Dog Park, Winfrey, boat clubs, etc.

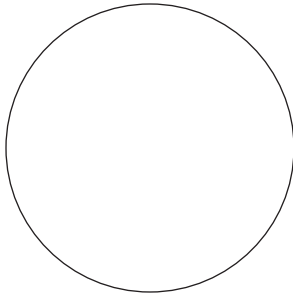

**After the public outcry over the West Lawther light poles, Councilman Kadane convened a task force to address lighting at the lake. The task force included key stakeholders:**

- White Rock Neighborhood Association
- Peninsula Neighborhood Association
- For the Love of the Lake
- Corinthian Sailing Club
- White Rock Boat House (rowing clubs)
- White Rock Lake Foundation
- Greater Dallas Bicycle Club

***The consensus of the Task Force was as follows:***

*Remove the W. Lawther light poles and plan no more there*
